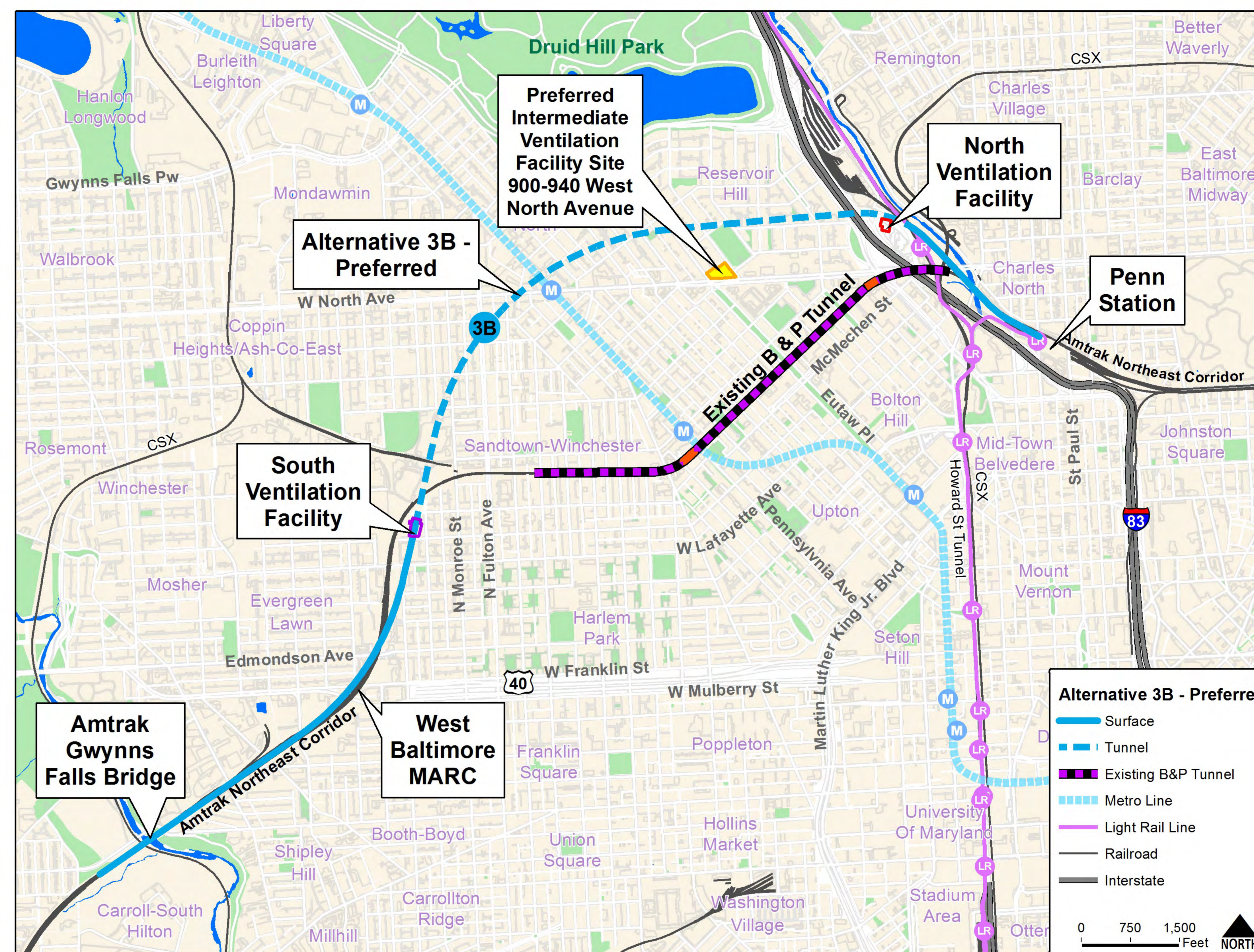


Welcome

The existing Baltimore and Potomac (B&P) Tunnel is a two-track railroad tunnel built in 1873 and located between Baltimore Penn Station and West Baltimore MARC Station along Amtrak's Northeast Corridor (NEC). Amtrak and MARC passenger trains, as well as Norfolk Southern freight trains, currently use the tunnel.
